

A **belly-landing** aka no-gear landing / wheels-up landing / gear-up touchdown

a medium-sized turbo prop

on the tail

the gear has perhaps collapsed

the wing root

to make an assessment of the damage

towed back to the hangar

propeller blades

bent (propellers)

to execute a belly-landing

the aircraft skidded on the runway

to lower the undercarriage

the warning was going off all the time

it was distracting the crew

the runway was occupied by another aircraft

to do a go-around

the gear was not extended

‘no’ = **NEGATIVE**

State / say / report / advise (your) intentions.

to **recycle** the landing gear = to perform a complete landing gear operation (extend-retract-extend)
