8. Are you a good negotiator? When was the last time you had to negotiate something?

9. Tell me about your greatest strength.

10. Tell me about your greatest weaknesses.

11. Tell me about a time you had to deal with a stressful situation.

12. What salary range are you looking for?

13. What has been your biggest professional achievement so far?

14. What has been your biggest professional failure so far?

15. Give us a good reason to hire you.
